

Toddler Group Planning

Spring Term

This terms' planning builds on the previous terms where it ended with the nativity and the birth of Jesus. It begins with Epiphany and explores Jesus as a child. The planning introduces special people in Jesus life such as Simeon and Anna and John the Baptist. This is followed by Jesus' baptism, moving then into Lent.

After half term the children can explore who Jesus is, celebrate Mother's day and moves into stories leading into Holy week.

Stories

Stories in the planning can be found in most children's Bibles and **feel free to use any versions** that suit the age of your children and your group. The planning makes reference to stories in **The Big Bible Storybook** and **The Play-Along Bible**. Both have good versions that make it easy to share stories with under 5's.

Occasionally other stories may be suggested throughout, these can usually be found cheaply online, with links provided. Again, use your own versions to fit with the theme if you have them.

Sensory Play

The planning includes weekly ideas for structured or sensory play. Young children learn through play and through their senses. Having opportunities for them to engage with themes in the story throughout the session can help to both develop their spirituality and help them understand the story.
