Ignatian Process of Prayer

- Value of attentiveness to prayer experience
- Three phases
 - 1. Approach & Engagement
 - 2. Focussed Spiritual Exercise
 - 3. Reflection and intimate conversation



From welcome to engagement

1. Approach & Engagement

'as you approach the place where you are going to pray, pause for about the length of an 'our Father' and consider how God is looking at you'

(Spiritual Exercises 75)

"Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake?

If you, then, ... know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!

(Matthew 7.9-11)

Ask for Grace.

Which fruit of Spirit do I seek?

- In leading others in prayer how do I help them receive God's loving gaze and seek God's grace?



 - Praying with Scripture lectio divina or imaginative contemplation of a gospel scene
 - Reflective exercises eg look back on your life...
 - Many other ways of engaging
 - Creative arts
 - Liturgical prayer The Office
 - Intercession
 - Tongues
 - Silence contemplative prayer
 - Prophetic prayer
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

Moving into greater intimacy with God

- 3. Reflection and Intimate conversation
- Separating reflection from activity
- Do the reflection after the engaged prayer
 - Allows engaged prayer be unselfconscious
 - Enables a deeper and more intimate conversation with God



Moving into greater intimacy with God

- 3. Reflection and Intimate conversation
- Looking back with a discerning eye
 - Where was my heart burning?
 - Give that greater time and attention to receive its gift.
 - Where was my heart distracted by other things?
 - What do I need from God here?
- Now move into deeper conversation with God Father, Son, Holy Spirit

3. Reflection and Intimate conversation

Heart to heart (as with a close friend)

The Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend.
