
Monday 7th December at 3:00pm (local time for Bishop Chris 9:00am) via Zoom

Historically: Bishop Adelbert Anson, the first Bishop of Qu'Appelle (1884), cultivated a relationship between Qu'Appelle and his home Diocese of Lichfield and with wealthy friends there. They briefly took on both the Diocese of Qu'Appelle as a mission field and the parish of St Peter's Pro-Cathedral as a particular focus of interest. Much of the early development of the St John's College Farm and the furnishing of St Peter's Pro-Cathedral are attributable to that early connection. Bishop Anson is buried in the churchyard of St Michael and All Angels in Colwich, Staffordshire.






